## SCENIC CHICAGO TOUR

This year, AIA and APA have engaged the Chicago Architecture Foundation to offer a tour of the city's architectural riches. Go on a three and half hour tour and discover the exciting diversity of Chicago's famous architecture on this wide-ranging odyssey, which traces the city's development from its beginning to the present. This tour covers 30 miles of Chicago architecture, including the Loop, Hyde Park, the Gold Coast, the lakefront, several historic districts, university campuses, parks, and old and new residential neighborhoods. Stops include the Rookery in downtown Chicago and Mies van der Rohe's IIT campus. The tour will be offered as follows:

Friday, January 4, 2008 from 1:00PM – 4:00PM  
Saturday, January 5, 2008 from 9:00AM – 12:00PM  
Sunday, January 6, 2008 from 1:00PM – 4:00PM  
Monday, January 7, 2008 from 9:00AM – 12:00PM

Tickets cost \$36 per person and include a guided tour on a luxury bus with restroom. Guests are welcome to bring food & beverage on the tour. Tickets can be purchased on the registration form, via online registration, or at the on-site booth in Chicago. Tickets purchased in advance are refundable only if cancellation is made by December 14, 2007. Tours are conducted rain or shine. Tours are subject to cancellation if a sufficient number of tickets are not sold. Each bus can hold 54 passengers; if a bus is not at maximum capacity, you may be contacted and asked to change dates.
