

OLIVIA JAMES TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP

Purpose: For travel and study in Greece, the Aegean Islands, Sicily, Southern Italy and Asia Minor.
(For further geographical restrictions, visit www.archaeological.org/fellowships)

Deadline: November 1; announced February 1

Amount: \$22,000

Requirements: Applicants must be U.S. citizens.

HELEN M. WOODRUFF FELLOWSHIP

Purpose: To support a Rome Prize Fellowship, with additional funds from the American Academy in Rome, for the study of archaeology or classical studies.

Deadline: November 1

Amount: \$10,000

Requirements: Applicants must be pre- or post-doctoral students and must be citizens or permanent residents of the U.S. Candidates must apply to the American Academy in Rome, 7 East 60th Street, New York, NY 10022.

ARCHAEOLOGY OF PORTUGAL FUND

Purpose: To support projects relating to the archaeology of Portugal.

Deadline: November 1; announced February 1

Amount: Amount varies according to project; typically \$4,000-\$10,000

Requirements: Portuguese, American, and international scholars are invited to apply.

ANNA C. AND OLIVER C. COLBURN FELLOWSHIP

Purpose: To support study for one year at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens, Greece.

Deadline: January 15, 2008; announced April 14

Amount: \$11,000 awarded bi-annually

Requirements: Applicants must be citizens or permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada, must be at the pre-doctoral stage or have received a Ph.D. within 5 years of application. Applicants must apply concurrently to the ASCSA for membership.

PUBLICATIONS GRANT

Purpose: To support the scholarly publication of previously excavated archaeological material. The grant is intended to assist in the final analysis, writing, and preparation for publication of the results of research. A completed manuscript (article or monograph) must be submitted for publication by the end of the second year of the grant.

Deadline: November 1; announced February 1

Amount: \$5,000 distributed in two yearly installments of \$2,500

Requirements: Proposals must include a timetable for completion of the manuscript and specific plans for publication (including intended publisher). Application is open to graduate students and scholars with a Ph.D.

HARRIET AND LEON POMERANCE FELLOWSHIP

Purpose: To support a project relating to Aegean Bronze Age archaeology

Deadline: November 1; announced February 1

Amount: \$4,000

Requirements: Applicants must be citizens or permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada or be actively pursuing an advanced degree at a North American college or university. Previous Pomerance fellows are not eligible.

All applicants must be members of the AIA at the time of application and until the end of the grant term.
