The AIA works to safeguard the world's archaeological heritage for future generations through direct preservation, raising awareness of threats to sites, education, and by facilitating the spread of best practices.

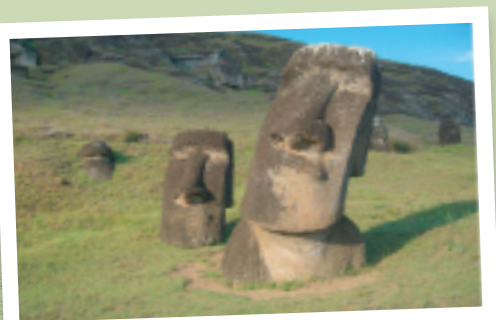
AWARD FOR BEST PRACTICES

Nominations for this award must be submitted to AIA's Site Preservation Program. Winners will be selected by a committee of professional archaeologists, conservators, and heritage specialists.

SITE PRESERVATION GRANT

The AIA's Site Preservation Grant maximizes global preservation efforts and awareness. The program supports projects that not only seek to preserve archaeological sites, but also emphasize outreach and education, with the intention of creating a positive impact on the local community, students, and the discipline of archaeology as a whole.

In addition to providing funding, the AIA works with the grant recipient to raise public awareness of the significance of archaeological sites and the threats they face, to implement and disseminate best practices, and to encourage increased support for preservation efforts.
