King Solomon's principal harbor and a major Canaanite, Phoenician, Israelite, Assyrian, Persian, Greek, and Roman city, Dor offers a unique opportunity for student volunteers to learn—on-site and in the classroom—everything from the archaeology of the Bronze Age Levant to the techniques of modern field archaeology, to the cutting-edge technology developed in our own laboratories. We are a one-of-a-kind teaching excavation located on a beautiful coastal site.

The UW Tel Dor 2014 Program Includes:

- *Accommodations at the K'far Galim Youth Village dorms (just up the coast from Dor; just south of Haifa)*
- *7 days/week room and board*
- *3-4 people/room (A/C, wi-fi, shared refrigerator access)*
- *On-site instruction in all aspects of modern archaeology*
- *Evening lectures by experienced on-staff researchers and scholars*
- *12 UW credits in either CLAS 399, NELC 399, ARCHY 270, or JSIS 399 (graded or C/NC)*
- *A field trip to the northern Galilee, including educational lectures, extreme mountain sledding, a rafting trip down the Jordan, a visit to Capernaum, and a dip in the Sea of Galilee*
- *Morning swims—if desired—on one of the most beautiful beaches on the Mediterranean Sea!*
