2024 Excavation Season HIPPOS (SUSSITA) EXCAVATIONS



The ancient city of Hippos, one of the Decapolis, is located upon the plateau of Sussita Mountain overlooking the Sea of Galilee.

The Hippos dig offers an exciting opportunity of uncovering an ancient city in one of the most dramatic sceneries in the region.

The team lodges in the beautiful kibbutz Ein-Gev on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.



During the upcoming season we plan on excavating the following areas in addition to conservation work:

- The Roman-period theater at the Saddle Compound
- A Roman period cardo and *insulae* around it

The Hippos 2024 field work will extend for four weeks: July 7<sup>th</sup> – August 1<sup>st</sup> 2024.

1. Two weeks participation

(minimum) – cost for full room and board: **\$1,650** 

**2. Four weeks** (full season) participation – cost for full room and board: **\$3,000** 

**3. Full season** with 8 semester credit units thorugh <u>CFS</u> (https://www. fieldsciences.org) – cost including full room and board: **\$4,600** 

During weekends (Fri-Sat) the participants choose whether to stay at the kibbutz (costs included) and rest, or travel in the region on their own.
