

CALL FOR APPLICANTS FOR THE 2020 FIELD SCHOOL { JULY 19 - AUGUST 15 }

EXCAVATE IN THE ALENTEJO REGION OF PORTUGAL!

THE PROJECT

Castelo sits atop the easternmost hill in a chain of three consecutive Bronze Age hilltop settlements in the Serra d'Ossa region. The project's third year of excavation has exciting prospects due to the site's massive size, surrounding wall, and various **Bronze Age** and **Iron Age** structures and artifacts. The 2018 season uncovered the biggest known Bronze Age hut in the Southwestern Iberian Peninsula. We intend to continue gathering material, architectural, and geographic data in order to grasp a better understanding of life and social structure during this period.

THE FIELD SCHOOL

Prior experience in archaeology is not required - students of all backgrounds are encouraged to apply. This field school will train students in archaeological methods, such as excavation techniques, recording, illustration, and the handling and processing of artifacts.

Students may attend for the 3 week or 4 week session. Tuition includes room, board, and transportation within Portugal. The application deadline is **May 15, 2020**. Students are encouraged to apply early as admission is on a rolling basis.

3 Week Session:

July 19 - August 8 / \$1500 USD

4 Week Session:

July 19 - August 15 / \$1850 USD
