UMSL's archaeological field school includes excavation at Iklaina (an ancient Greek palace from the time of the Trojan War), museum and lab work, travel to archaeological sites and museums, and lectures on Greek history, archaeology, art, and mythology. Students receive 6 credits through History. Open also to members of the community as a non-credit course.
