

## Archaeological Field School

### What are we doing?

The field school aims to train students in archaeological excavation and related themes such as:

- Excavation Methods
- Stratigraphy
- Excavation Photos
- Surveying and Mapping
- Geo-Archaeology
- Processing of finds
- Building techniques and preservation



### How will the school be organised?

The students are participating in the excavation and can be accommodated directly on site in the „Grabungshaus“. There we can offer rooms with 4 to 8 beds, washing facilities and a kitchen. Practical work will be conducted on the site, finds processing as well as theoretical lectures will take place in the „Grabungshaus“. The academic credits for students will be 6 ECTS.

### Where will it take place?

The field school will take place in the Roman town Aguntum near modern Lienz, Austria. The town became a *municipium* during the reign of emperor Claudius and was inhabited at least until the 5th century AD. Currently we are excavating the *Forum Area* of the town.



### When will we start?

The excavation will last for 7 weeks in July and August 2021. The field school will take place from 12.07.2021 to 08.08.2021 (4 weeks).

### How much will it cost?

The costs are 1.800 Euros p. P. for four weeks. These are not including transfer and accommodation. The latter can be organized on site for a reasonable price.
