- Participate in an archaeological field school, learn the fundamentals of excavation methods. No prior experience in archaeology is necessary.
- Learn the history of the largest classical site in Israel from the Hellenistic to Ottoman periods. Caesarea Maritima was once the capital of Roman and Byzantine Palestine.
- **6 credits in 2 courses** (HIS 390/HIS 697) on the archaeology and history of the city.
- Includes two day field trips to sites in Israel in the north Galilee and to Jerusalem.
- Study Abroad includes all room and board in Israel, program related travel expenses, International Programs fee, insurance, museum and archaeological site entrances for one field trips. **Cost = \$4,500.00, not including airfare.**
- Financial Aid applicable for travel and scholarships/grants available.
